Re: Part 11 Order Request – Second Avenue Infrastructure Improvements

We have been advised by the MOE that our Part 11 Order request will be considered once a Notice of Completion has been re-issued for the project. We have been copied correspondence to you directing the completion of all required consultations, impact assessments and documentation needed for the Notice of Completion including creation of a Project File.

Due to nature and scope of the project and cost, particularly as we understand the second phase of the project is to be included as part of the whole, the city as proponent should consider the elevation of the project to a higher schedule, in this case from a B to a C to better address the issues as well as to potentially avoid a Part 11 Order request related to the determination of the appropriate Schedule.

Whether a Schedule B or C in Phase 2 of the EA process we would expect the identifying of alternative planning solutions taking into consideration the existing environment and to determine the preferred solution including those suggested in our Part 11 Order request to the MOE.

It is in this regard that we are prepared to meet with you at the earliest opportunity to begin to take part in the process.

We think you agree that it is important that all the time necessary be taken in order to ensure that all the various elements are addressed. In particular special attention needed due to the controversial nature of the potential impacts of the project on air and water quality. Also of consideration are safety concerns and the effects on adjacent businesses and the residential community.

We look forward to meeting as soon as convenient.
